

## **MoUs and LoIs worth 45,000 crore signed in Dubai Expo**

**Dubai Expo proved to be a successful event for the Rajasthan in terms of the investment it has promised to bring in.**

MoUs & LoIs worth about Rs45,000 crore were got signed during Rajasthan Week organised from 12th to 18th November at Indian Pavilion. It included 30 MoUs worth Rs29,000 crore & 24 LoI worth Rs 16,000 crore.

Proposed investment includes Rs10,000 crore for Petrochemical sector, Rs7,500 crore for Renewable Energy sector, Rs5,500 crore for Health sector, Rs4,500 crore for Agro Processing sector & around Rs4,000 crore for Start-ups. Besides these, MoUs & LoIs in other sectors like Logistics, Ceramic, Stone, Real Estate, e-waste recycling, IT and Tourism were also got signed.

The proposed investment is expected to generate around employment opportunity for 77,000 persons.
